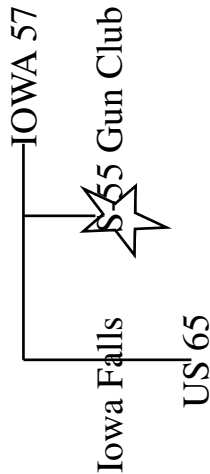


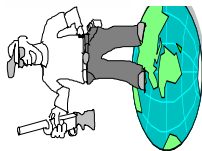

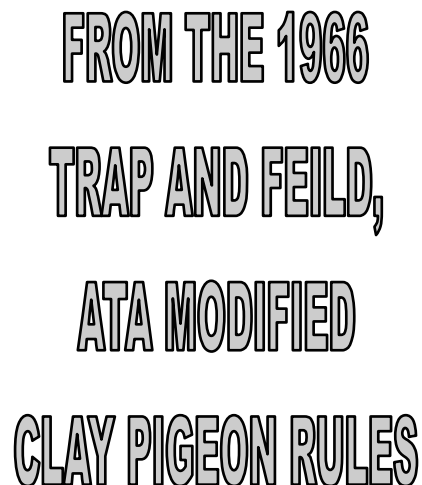

Shooting Arrangement

1. Shooting should be carried out in squads of five shooters with one shooter at each of the five stations.

2. The shooter, rotating, shall shoot at five targets from his starting station before the shooters change station.

3. Trapshoots, shooting stations, etc., shall be as in standard ATA rules except that shooters shall shoot at 17 yards.

4. If the standard International 15-trap layout is used, squads shall consist of six shooters, and the shooters shall move after each shot.

B. Guns, Ammunition

1. No shooter shall use a gun larger than 12 gauge.

2. The powder charge shall not exceed 1 1/4 ounces and shall not be larger than No. 7 in size.

3. Powder charge shall not exceed 3 1/4 drams equivalent.

4. The powder charge shall be only one three malfunctions of gun or ammunition per round of 25 targets. A malfunction is any failure of gun or ammunition not directly caused by the shooter himself. It is not a malfunction if the shell is fired and the powder waste leaves the barrel.

C. Traps, Targets and Flight

1. Traps which simultaneously oscillate automatically in both horizontal and vertical directions shall be used. The standard International range of 15 traps may also be used.

2. Targets shall be the standard ATA target, but the heavier, more rugged International target is recommended to reduce breakage in throwing.

3. Targets shall be thrown as follows:

- a. Distance of at least 6 yards and 11 feet, measured 10 yards from the trap.
- b. Distance of at least 65 yards measured in still air on level ground when the target is thrown at a 9 to 10-foot elevation (about 17°). Spectator judges of the target's position are available.
- c. The maximum angles thrown at in their oscillation shall be approximately 45° right and left of straightaway. Most standard traps must be altered to meet this specification.

D. Scoring

1. A shooter may fire two shots at each target and no difference shall be indicated in the score whether the target was hit by the first, second or even third shot. If the first shot misses and the shooter then has an allowable second shot, he shall be entitled to another target but must miss the new target with the first shot and the result of the second shot only shall be the score. If the shooter breaks a target, he shall be scored "1".

2. The target shall be scored "dead" if a visible piece is broken from it or if it is completely reduced to dust.

3. The target shall be scored "1" if:

- a. It is missed completely.
- b. It is only "dusted" (no visible piece falls from it).
- c. The shooter does not fire.
- d. The gun is not loaded, closed, cocked or the safety is on.
- e. The shooter fails to fire and does anything which prevents the referee from determining whether the failure to fire was due to the shooter's own fault or due to a malfunction of the gun.
- f. A fourth or subsequent malfunction occurs in a round of 25 targets.

4. It shall be "no target" and another target allowed whether or not the competitor breaks the first.

5. If the target is thrown broken.

6. If the target takes an irregular course (it flutters, has insufficient velocity, etc.)

7. If the target is of noticeably different color from the others.

8. If the targets are not thrown in the proper order.

9. If two shooters fire at the same target.

10. If a shooter shoots out of turn.

11. If there is a fast and slow shot.

12. If the first shot misses and the target is thrown if the shooter has not fired.

13. If he fires two shots and:

- a. The first shot is a bullseye.
- b. The first shot still misses and he does not fire the second shot. If he fires the second shot 2 must be scored.

14. If a gun "doubles" it can be scored when called to shoot. If absent, they shall be dropped to a later position as decided by the management.

E. Competitors' Duties.

1. Competitors shall be on time when called to shoot. If absent, they shall be dropped to a later position as decided by the management.

2. All competitors, if requested, are subject to duty as auxiliary referees to assist the referee.

Three of the four class singles awards were settled by tie-breakers during the Feb. 20 competition at the Ft. Worth (Tex.) GASC. W. E. Euston was the only one to win a class singles trophy. He took off. His 98 was high in A. Dr. John Riggs beat Jerry Keen in an extra round for the B laurels after they knotted with 95, and Dr. Deane W. Moore was victorious over Riley Plunkett in C after they tied with 93, and James McInnis and James W. Clark shot the same 92 in D. Eustons' 98 was the highest. Clark, winning Carl Harman's 88 topped the women, and Mike Hayer was the junior leader with 87.

Dr. Deane W. Moore led a 96 from 20 yards to lead handicapper runnerup Don Mercer by two targets. Concess Herring and Mona Riggs shared the spotlight in the 30-yard class. Herring's 94 was the highest. J. D. White headed the doubles field of 30 with 45, while Clark and Marvin Plunkett tied for second with 44. A series of darkness they flipped for the prize, with Clark winning.

Modified Wobble Iowa State Shoot Rules

A Shooting Assignment

1. Shooting shall be carried out in squads of five with one shooter from each of the five stations.
2. Each shooter, in rotation, shall shoot five targets from his starting station before shooters change stations.
3. Traphouse shooting stations etc. shall be as in standard ATA rules except shooters shoot from the **24 yardline**.

B. Guns and Ammunition

1. No shooter shall use a gun larger than 12 ga.
2. The shot charge will not exceed 1 1/8 oz of 7 1/2 shot size.
3. Powder charge will not exceed 3 dram.

C. Traps, Targets and Flight

1. Traps will simultaneously oscillate in both horizontal and vertical directions.
2. Targets are standard ATA targets.
3. Targets will be thrown as follows.
 - a. Varying height between very low and very high.
 - b. To a distance that is as far as can be thrown without breakage not to exceed 85 yards.
 - c. The maximum angles thrown by the trap in its fullest oscillation permitted without targets hitting the trap house upon exit.

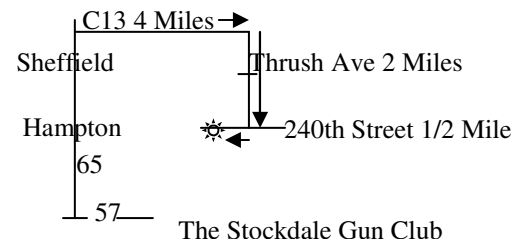

Event 1

Single shot event

Shooter shall have only one shot to shoot at one single target.
Shooters shoot five targets in rotation from each of the five shooting stations.
25 shells required per trap, 50 targets per event

Event 2

Two shot event

Shooter may fire two shots at each target and no difference shall be indicated in the score whether the target is hit with the first, second or both shots. If the first shot is a miss and the shooter then has an allowable malfunction, he shall be entitled to one shot at a new target.
Shooters shoot five targets in rotation from each of the five shooting stations.
Shooter may have up to two allowable malfunctions according to current ATA rules.
25 to 50 shells required per trap, 50 targets per event.

Event 3

Report pair event

Shooter shall have only one shot to shoot at one single target. Upon report of the first target a second target is then thrown. The same shooter shall have only one shot to shoot at the second single target.
Shooter shall have up to two allowable malfunctions according to current ATA rules, with the exception if you miss on the first bird the pair is scored as lost pair. 50 shells required per trap 100 target, 50 pair per trap event

Modified Wobble Iowa State Shoot Notes

- All guns must be open at all times unless it is your turn to shoot in position.
- No shells left in the chambers when changing positions and or stations.
- All other ATA rules enforced.
- Everyone shall have hearing and eye protection at all posts or stations.
- Having fun is a requirement.
- Food available at the club house.
- Shells available at the club.
- 25 single practice targets is \$6.50, honor system.
- Practice from 8:00 Am to 10:00 Am.
- No guns or gun cases in the club house.
- No pets or smoking in the club house.
- Veterans, 65+, Ladies, and Juniors must declare at entry.
- When it is your turn to shoot please close your gun not to point at the voice release systems. Cords are 75.00 control box is 400.00, you shoot it, you may own it.
- We may alter the program during conditions beyond our control.
- Entries and option money refunded as long as you didn't shoot the event.
- Option money payoffs will be mailed.
- Please use a shell catcher, and a shell bag. Help keep us litter free.
- Clay carts are allowed behind, south side of main sidewalk, but not in front of the brick club house.
