Stuff you ought to know.

- All ATA(\$3.00), ISTA(\$3.00), Central Zone (\$1.50) fees and targets are subject to county 1% and state 6% sales tax(7%).
- 100 straight pins are here, 200 straight and 100 straight doubles pins are given to first time achievers.
- Practice on any ending trap before an event, \$5.00, honor system.
- No prizes will be shipped. You or your representative may pick them up anytime up to one year anniversary of the event.
- We are not responsible for accidents, theft, or the weather.
- We may alter the program due to conditions beyond our control.
- Empties on the ground are gun club property.
- Entries and options can be refunded as long as you did not shoot.
- Golf cart users must only be operated South of the main sidewalk. No golf carts allowed on the sidewalk during the events.
- When it is your turn, please close your guns so that the gun is not aiming at any of the voice release equipment. Cords are \$75.00 and the control box is \$400.00. Shoot it, you may own it.
- All Camping is first come first served until the Heartland Grand.
- Ear and eve protection rules enforced.
- Open or out rule enforced along with all other safety rules.
- Please use your shell bag. It costs the club to pick up your empties. Help us make this weekend event litter free!
- Management has the right to move squads to balance the trap line at anytime any event.
- Most important: We are glad you are here!

Shooters responsibility


- 1 By entering the grounds everyone agrees to abide by the ATA rules.
- 2 Be ready to shoot. Squads will not wait for tardy members. If you miss your squad, we will help you resquad. No extra charge. Management may change the order of squads.
- 3 Do not sign up in the last squads of a first event and the first squads of a second event. You will not make It. We do not stop the shooting between events, even while changing over to doubles.
- 4 Check your score after each five targets. Know what a dead bird score looks like.
- 5 Special categories indicate at entry. Check the score board. Errors will be corrected upon discovery.
- 6 Bring your plastic card. Average your scores. Declare your age and/or category.
- 7 Please tell the area businesses you're here for the shoot.
- 8 Keep pets out of the club house. No smoking in main brick club house.
- 9 No gun cases in the club house.



ATA Trophies and Added Money

All ATA Central Zone residents who compete at any of the shooting locations compete for all trophies and added money provided by the ATA. Any person who wins one of these trophies while shooting at the Stockdale Gun Club (SGC) is still eligible for the SGC trophy in that event. All added money is awarded with trophy. Ties for added money do not divide.

Registration Certificate

This certifies that the Stockdale Gun Club has been authorized to hold a registered shoot at Ackley, Iowa on July 31, - August 2, 2015.

Qualification Requirements

To assure equitable classification and handicapping, a specific number of targets must be shot in 2014 and 2015 combined with a certain minimum of them being shot in 2015, prior to July 31, 2015

PENALTY CLASSES AND HANDICAPS YARDAGE

Those not meeting the target requirements shall be assigned penalty class and yardage as follows.

For women and sub-juniors, the minimum shall be class B singles and Class C in doubles respectively NOTE: PENALTY YARDAGE WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: YOUR CURRENT ATA ASSIGNED YARDAGE PLUS A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YARDS TO A MAXIMUM OF 27 YARDS. Example: Shooter A: ATA assigned yardage is 22 yards, plus the two (2) yard penalty; the shooter shoots from the twenty-four (24) yardline. Shooter B; ATA assigned yardage is 26 yards, plus a one (1) yard penalty, shooter shoots from the twenty-seven (27) yardline.

Penalty yardage will be waived for senior veterans.

Information
SPECIAL CATEGORIES

IT IS THE SHOOTERS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL SPECIAL CATEGORIES (Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veterans, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

- 1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
- 2. A female shooter, who has reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
- 3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday may declare Sub-Junior.
- 4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday may declare as Junior.
- 5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
- 6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th birthday may declare as a Sub Veteran.
- 7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th birthday may declare as a Veteran.
- 8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran. Continue page 4

All-Around scores recorded by computer, check your scores at the scoreboard.

Ties: Shot off at the end of each day, or as otherwise announced. Absentees forfeit.

There will be no shoot-offs for Friday's Class 16 yard or Class Doubles.

These ties will carry over to Saturday 16 yard, Sunday Doubles respectively.

Squading is first available post or squad no exceptions, we will rotate backs daily.

Have your shoot record, Average card accurate and up-to-date.

Effective 18 March 2015, for Satellite Grands and ATA Zone Shoots:

All American Points Pins are no longer considered to be trophies by themselves. This means that category shooters who earn a "Pin-Only" award (e.g., 3rd Place in the Singles Championship) in their category are eligible to win a class, place, or yardage group trophy.

All shooters, regardless of class, category or yardage group are eligible to win the "Event Champion" All American Points Pin.

Only non-category shooters are eligible to win All American Points Pins for any "Open" place (i.e., $R/U-3^{rd}$ in the Class events, $R/U-5^{th}$ in the Preliminary Handicap, $R/U-4^{th}$ in the Singles and Doubles Championship events, and $R/U-10^{th}$ in the Handicap Championship event).

NOTE: Because of these new rules, in the Class Singles and Doubles events it will be possible for a category shooter to win any of the trophies available since there are no category trophies, only category points pins. Effective 18 March 2015, for Satellite Grands and ATA Zone Shoots:

Shoot-Offs/Carry-Overs

From the ATA Rule Book, page 60:

"In the event that no Trophy is awarded and contestants are eligible and tied for All American Points Pins, ties may be decided by their reverse score on the events in question on full sub events. If ties still exist shoot management may resolve ties by coin flips or other gaming methods. All point pin positions for categories and for open classes will be decided in this way."

The Zone Shoot Administrator will upload the reverse scores and carry over scores necessary to resolve any ties for "points pin only" awards.
