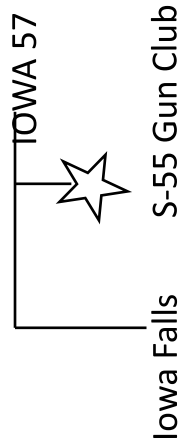

Events will begin at dark

All of Tonight's Friday Night Lights events are under the shoot-off lights featuring White-Flyer all white pitch targets.

Event 1

10 Bird 16 Yard "Walk Across" 15.00

10.00 each entry added to the purse, one money ties settled by dividing or "Long Bird" shoot off

Event 2

25 Bird Night Race 35.00

17.00 each entry added to purse, divided 50/30/20
10.00 each entry to the Lewis purse, 3 Classes one Money

Event 3

50 Bird Race 50.00

15.00 added to the purse divided 50/30/20
15.00 added to the Lewis purse, 3 classes, one money
(First class is after the top three scores.)

10 Bird Walk Across

10 Bird Walk Across is shot from the 16 yard line. All entrants will form a single line behind the first shooter on post one. The first shooter will shoot two targets and move to post two and the next shooter will move up to post one. The number one shooter will now lead off firing one shot, the shooter on post one will follow with one shot until they have both fired two shots. The leader will move on to post three, shooter on one moves to two and another contestants joins on post one. Then the leader shoots the first shot and they repeat the process till the squad is full. As each contestant has fired two shot form each post, they exit from post 5. It is like a follow the leader and around of 16s shot backwards. The process continues unit all the contestants have fired 2 shots from each post, hence, walk across and done.

Long Bird Shoot Off

Long Bird shoot off. In the event that ties do not divide, the event will be settled by a long bird shoot off. The tied contestants will shoot from approximately 40 yards behind the trap house, settled by miss and out.

25 Bird Night Race

25 Bird Night Race. Shooters will squad up and shoot 2 birds per post (10 birds) from the 16 yard line. Then double the 16 yard score add 7 targets, that will be the yardage will be your of your handicap. 3 per post will be shot at (15 birds). Minimum yardage for this event will be 19 yards. 2 yards yardage difference on a squad. Longest yardage determines the shortest distance per squad.

50 Bird Race

50 Bird Race. Shooters shoot 25 from 16 yard line. Then shoot another 25 from their established ATA yardage. Shooters winning any previous event may earn a yardage advance. Shooter are squadded by yardage. New shooters begin at the 20 yard line.

Halloween Handicap

Halloween Handicap 100 nonregistered ATA style target event. Yardage determined four ways. By current ATA yardage, known abilities and past wins and or a combination of all. One yard added for each time they have won or tied in the non-registered Halloween Handicap Contestants will shoot 25 per trap. Minimum yardage is the 20 yard.

Fast Eddie Slider

Fast Eddie Slider is a 100 target event. Contestants will be squadded by ATA handicap yardage with no more than 2 yards differences. Know ability may also apply to yardage establishment. Non ATA shooters will be squadded at the 22 yard line. The event his held as 4 25 target sub-events. The first is shot from the 16 yard, the second trap move to the 20 yard line, next move to the 22 yard line, then the last trap is shot from the established ATA earned yardage. The event is shot over 4 traps.

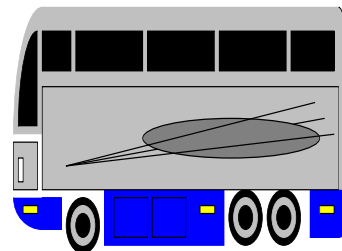

Check your score after each five targets shoot on each post. Make sure you know what a dead bird score looks like.

Keep pets out of the club house. No smoking in any building or under any awning.

Check the your scores, check the scores on the board. Errors corrected upon discovery.

All payoffs will be tabulated and sent at the end of the shoot.

We are not responsible,for accidents or theft or the weather.

We may alter the program during conditions beyond our control.

Entries can be refunded as long as you did not shoot.

All golf cart users must only be operated South of the main sidewalk. No golf carts allowed on the sidewalk during the events. Please no carts infront of the brick club house.

When it is your turn please close your guns so that the gun is not aiming at any of the voice release equipment.

Cords are \$75.00 and the control box is \$400.00. Shoot it, you may own it.

Ear and eye protection rules enforced.

Open or out rule enforced along with all other safety rules.
